These slides were created at November 15, 1976.

They were created by Tomas Ohlin, then working at the National Board for Technical Development, the central public research board in Stockholm, Sweden (with drawing aid). The slides are aimed to exemplify – at the time – new technological communication possibilities, used for social applications, like education, health care, personal communication, entertainment etc.

The drawings were used at numerous public performances and open discussions around the topic of new social possibilities with the help of fresh communication technology. A concept that often was discussed was the nature of the information society. Project TERESE was often addressed.

The final slide aims to make the point that there may be situations in life where even the most advanced telecommunications service may face its limits.



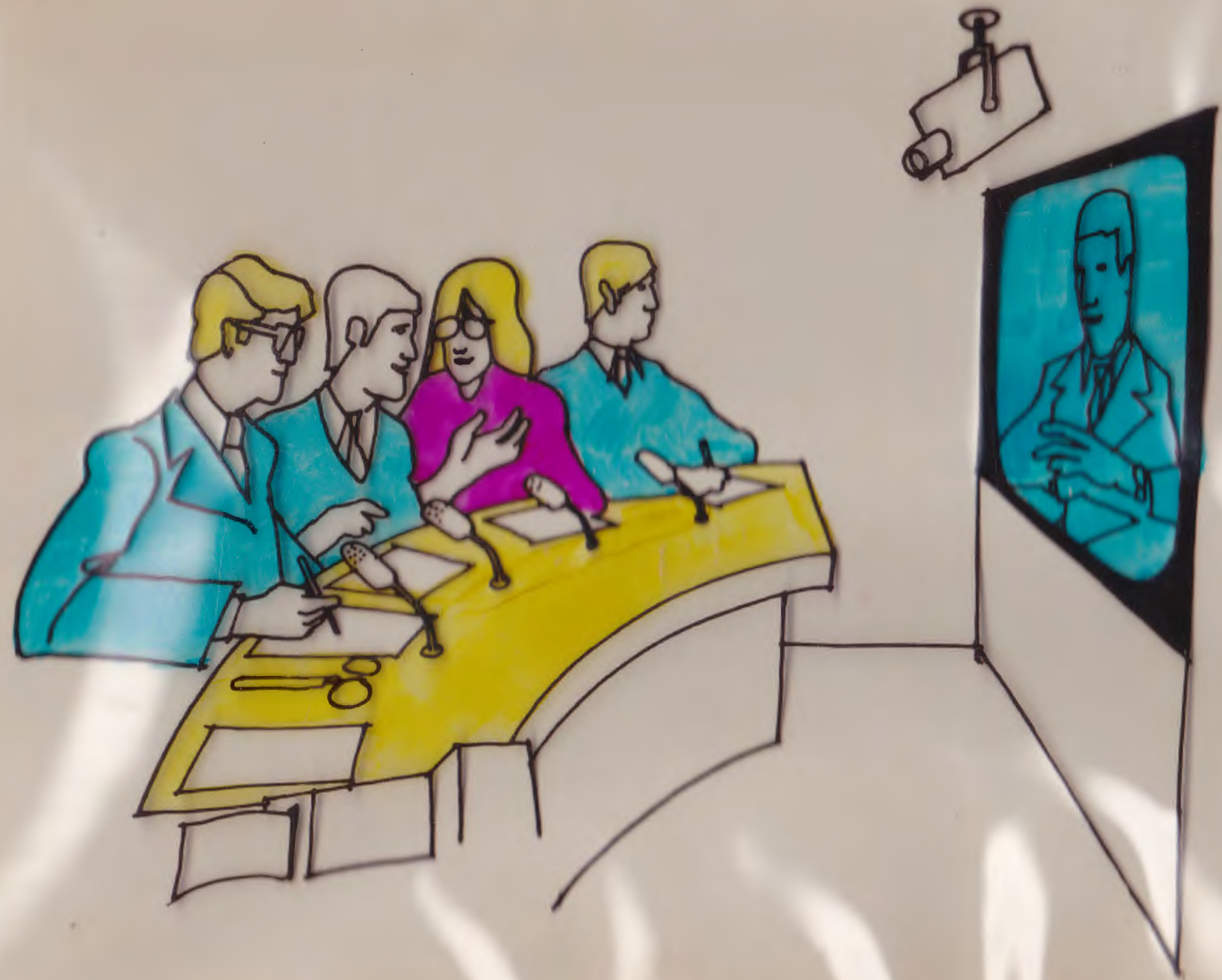
